ADMISSION NOTIFICATION

Subject: Commencement of Phase-II of Undergraduate Admissions for passouts of the Biannual / Supplementary / Private Examination of Class 12th, Session 2026, to Four-Year Undergraduate Programs (FYUGP) / 5-Year Integrated P.G. Programs (IPG) with multiple-exit options, for the Academic Session 2026-27.

The Department of Higher Education, Government of Jammu & Kashmir, announces the commencement of Phase-II of admissions for the Academic Session 2026-27 to Four-Year Undergraduate Programs (FYUGP) / 5-Year Integrated P.G. Programs (IPG) with multiple-exit options across Government Degree Colleges of J&K, against leftover vacant seats and seats reclaimed on account of cancellation / non-payment of fee after the conclusion of Phase-I.

Phase-II is being opened consequent upon the declaration of the results of the Biannual / Supplementary / Private Examination of Class 12th, Session 2026, by the Jammu & Kashmir Board of School Education and other recognised Boards, so that candidates qualifying in the said examinations are not deprived of admission to higher education in the current academic session.

Admissions in Phase-II shall be conducted through the Centralised Admission Portal <https://jkadmissions.in>, on the basis of 10+2 merit, eligibility and availability of vacant seats.

A. Eligibility

The following categories of candidates are eligible to participate in Phase-II, subject to fulfilment of the prescribed eligibility conditions:

1. Candidates who have qualified the Biannual / Supplementary / Private Examination of Class 12th, Session 2026, conducted by JKBOSE or any other recognised Board;
2. Candidates who had registered on the Admission Portal during Phase-I but did not secure admission in any college / programme;
3. Candidates who were allotted a seat in any round of Phase-I but did not complete the admission formalities;
4. Candidates whose applications were rejected during verification on account of incorrect information, marks, category claims or eligibility issues, provided they now satisfy all applicable eligibility conditions.

Candidates who have already secured and confirmed admission in any Government Degree College during Phase-I, and candidates who cancelled a confirmed admission, shall not be eligible to participate in Phase-II.

Admissions shall be made against vacant seats under Open Merit, CDP and Achievement Categories, including NCC, NSS, ECA and Sports. All vacant non-supernumerary category seats, excluding CDP and Achievement Category seats, shall stand converted to Open Merit for Phase-II.



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B. Modes of Admission

Vacant seats in Phase-II shall be filled through **two parallel modes**:

- Programmes listed at **Annexure 'A'** — through **In-Person Counselling** at the colleges concerned.
- Programmes listed at **Annexure 'B'** — through **Walk-in Admission** at the colleges concerned.

Candidates shall be free to participate in both modes during Phase-II. A candidate who secures admission in a walk-in programme listed at Annexure 'B' may nevertheless attend in-person counselling for a programme listed at Annexure 'A', and a candidate admitted through in-person counselling may likewise seek walk-in admission in a programme listed at Annexure 'B'. Where a candidate subsequently accepts another seat, the earlier admission shall stand modified accordingly and the fee already paid shall be adjusted in accordance with the rules in force. This will be available only in respect of admissions secured during Phase-II.

C. Admission Schedule

All aspirants are required to register on the Centralised Admission Portal <https://jkadmissions.in> before proceeding for admission under either mode.

D. Registration, Documents and Fee

Documents required for registration. Clear and legible scanned copies (PDF/JPG format, not exceeding 1 MB each) of the following documents are required at the time of registration:

1. Class 12th Marks Card
2. Class 10th Marks Card



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3. Domicile Certificate (if available)
4. Recent passport size photograph
5. Aadhaar Number
6. Category Certificate (if any)

(Category certificates that are under process / incomplete / pending with the competent authority shall not be accepted.)

Registration Fee. Candidates who have not applied earlier shall submit their application online on <https://jkadmissions.in> and pay the prescribed non-refundable application fee of **₹200 (Rupees two hundred only)**. Candidates who had already applied during Phase-I, but had not secured admission in Phase-I, need not register again and shall not be required to pay any additional application fee; such candidates shall, however, log in to the Portal and update their Class 12th result particulars before proceeding.

Counselling & Facilitation Centres. Aspirants are advised to visit the Counselling and Facilitation Centres established at all Government Degree Colleges of J&K for assistance in registration and submission of choices, so as to avoid mistakes.

Exploring courses before submitting choices. Aspirants should explore the courses available across all colleges before submitting their choices available on the Centralised Admission Website.

All candidates are advised to carefully verify their mobile number and email address on the Portal to ensure timely receipt of admission-related communications.

E. In-Person Counselling for Programmes Listed at Annexure 'A'

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1. Candidates who have not applied earlier must register on the Centralised Admission Portal and pay the prescribed application fee. Candidates who have already applied during Phase-I, but not completed admission formalities, need not register again.
 2. All participating candidates must submit fresh programme choices on the Portal as per the schedule notified at Section C above, even if they had submitted choices during Phase-I.
 3. The choices shall be treated independently, and their order shall not affect admission during this round. Aspirants are advised to submit a sufficient number of well-considered choices, as candidates submitting too few choices reduce their own chances of admission.
 4. Colleges shall publish their college-wise in-person counselling schedules, indicating the venue and reporting time, on <https://jkadmissions.in> and on their notice boards on 05-09-2026. Candidates must check the Portal for the schedule applicable to them.
 5. Candidates must personally report to the college concerned on the notified date and at the notified time, with all required original documents.
 6. Where seats remain vacant after a counselling session, the college shall notify a further counselling schedule and conduct successive counselling sessions until the available seats are exhausted or the last date is reached, whichever is earlier.

Mode of admission.

1. Among the candidates who report for counselling, admission shall be made strictly on the basis of merit, applicable reservation rules, programme eligibility and availability of vacant seats.
2. Admissions under CDP and Achievement Categories shall be made according to the applicable norms of the affiliating university and on the basis of merit.



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3. Submission of an application or of programme choices does not guarantee admission. Admission shall be confirmed only after physical reporting at the college as per its published schedule, on the basis of merit among the candidates reporting, and after verification of original documents and payment of the prescribed fee online.
4. A candidate who secures admission during counselling may attend counselling for another chosen programme or college. If the candidate subsequently accepts another seat, the earlier admission shall stand modified and the fee already paid shall be adjusted in accordance with the rules in force.

F. Walk-in Admission for Programmes Listed at Annexure 'B'

For colleges and programmes listed at **Annexure 'B'**, eligible candidates may directly approach the college concerned for walk-in admission from 01-09-2026 up to 10-09-2026, subject to availability of vacant seats. Candidates seeking walk-in admission **must be registered on the Centralised Admission Portal before reporting to the college**, and the admission fee shall be deposited online through the Portal only. The admission process, including payment of the online fee and physical verification of original documents, must be completed by the same date.

Where the number of candidates reporting for a walk-in programme exceeds the seats available, admission shall be granted on the basis of merit lists drawn up by the college from among the applications received, strictly on the basis of 10+2 merit.

G. Important Instructions

1. Candidates must satisfy the eligibility conditions prescribed for the programme concerned by the affiliating university.
2. Incorrect information relating to marks, category, eligibility or any other admission matter may result in cancellation of candidature or admission at any stage.
3. No request for correction of merit-related information shall be accepted after final submission.
4. Confirmation of admission shall be subject to the minimum number of students prescribed for a course by the Higher Education Department.
5. Candidates must provide a valid mobile number and email address for admission-related communication.
6. Candidates should regularly visit <https://jkadmissions.in> for notices, schedules and other updates, and may also follow the official Admissions 2026-27 WhatsApp Channel linked on the Admission Portal.
7. The decision of the Admission Committee or the Competent Authority regarding eligibility, merit, document verification and admission shall be final and binding.
8. Candidates must check the number of vacant seats available in various programmes on the Centralised Admission Portal jkadmissions.in before applying for admission.

H. After Admission — Induction and NEP Orientation

Newly admitted students are advised to attend the induction sessions conducted by their respective colleges, which will orient them on the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 framework, the FYUGP curriculum, and the structure of Major, Minor, Multi-Disciplinary, Value-Added, Ability Enhancement and Skill Enhancement courses. Students are also



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encouraged to familiarise themselves with key NEP features, including the option of switching between Major and Minor at the 3rd semester, the possibility of pursuing PG in the Minor, direct PhD eligibility on completion of the 4-Year Honours-with-Research track, multiple exit and re-entry options, and the credit-based academic system.

Phase-II of undergraduate admissions for the Academic Session 2026-27 shall stand concluded on **10-09-2026**, and no admission shall be effected after that date.

Aspirants are advised to regularly check **<https://jkadmissions.in>** and to follow the official WhatsApp Channel for Admissions 2026-27, linked on the Admission Portal, for regular updates.
